COOKIES POLICY

What are cookies?

A cookie is any type of data storage and retrieval device that is used on a user's terminal equipment for the purpose of storing information and retrieving information already stored, as established in article 22.2 of Law 34/2002, of 11 July, services of the information society and electronic commerce (LSSI).

This website uses cookies and/or similar technologies that store and retrieve information when you browse. In general, these technologies can serve very different purposes, such as recognizing you as a user, obtaining information about your browsing habits, or customizing the way the content is displayed. The specific uses we make of these technologies are described below.

Types of cookies

Next, a classification of cookies is made based on a series of categories. However, it is necessary to take into account that the same cookie can be included in more than one category.

Types of cookies according to the entity that manages them

a) Own cookies: are those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain managed by the editor itself and from which the service requested by the user is provided.

b) Third-party cookies: are those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain that is not managed by the editor but by another entity that processes the data obtained through cookies.

Types of cookies according to their purpose

a) Technical cookies: Are those that allow the user to navigate through a web page, platform or application and use the different options or services that exist, including those that the editor uses to allow the management and operation of the website and enable its functions and services, such as controlling traffic and data communication, identifying the session, accessing parts of restricted access, remembering the elements that make up an order, carrying out the purchase process of a order, manage payment, control fraud linked to the security of the service, make the request for registration or participation in an event, count

visits for the purpose of billing software licenses with which the service works (website, platform or application), use security elements during navigation, store content for the dissemination of videos or sound, enable dynamic content icons (for example, animation loading a text or image) or sharing content through social networks.

b) Preference or personalization cookies: these are those that allow you to remember information so that the user accesses the service with certain characteristics that can differentiate their experience from that of other users, such as, for example, the language, the number of results to show when The user performs a search, the aspect or content of the service depending on the type of browser through which the user accesses the service or the region from which he accesses the service, etc.

c) Analysis or measurement cookies: are those that allow the person responsible for them to monitor and analyze the behavior of the users of the websites to which they are linked, including the quantification of the impacts of the advertisements. The information collected through this type of cookies is used in the measurement of the activity of the websites, application or platform, in order to introduce improvements based on the analysis of the usage data made by the users of the service.

d) Behavioral advertising cookies: they are those that store information on the behavior of users obtained through the continuous observation of their browsing habits, which allows developing a specific profile to show advertising based on it.

Types of cookies according to the period of time they remain activated.

a) Session cookies: are those designed to collect and store data while the user accesses a web page. They are usually used to store information that only interests to keep for the provision of the service requested by the user on a single occasion and disappear at the end of the session.

b) Persistent cookies: are those in which the data is still stored in the terminal and can be accessed and processed during a period defined by the person responsible for the cookie.

Cookies used by this website

This website uses sessions, technical, and analysis cookies. The cookies used are, in any case, temporary, with the sole purpose of making navigation more efficient. In no case do these cookies provide personal data on their own and are not used to collect them.
